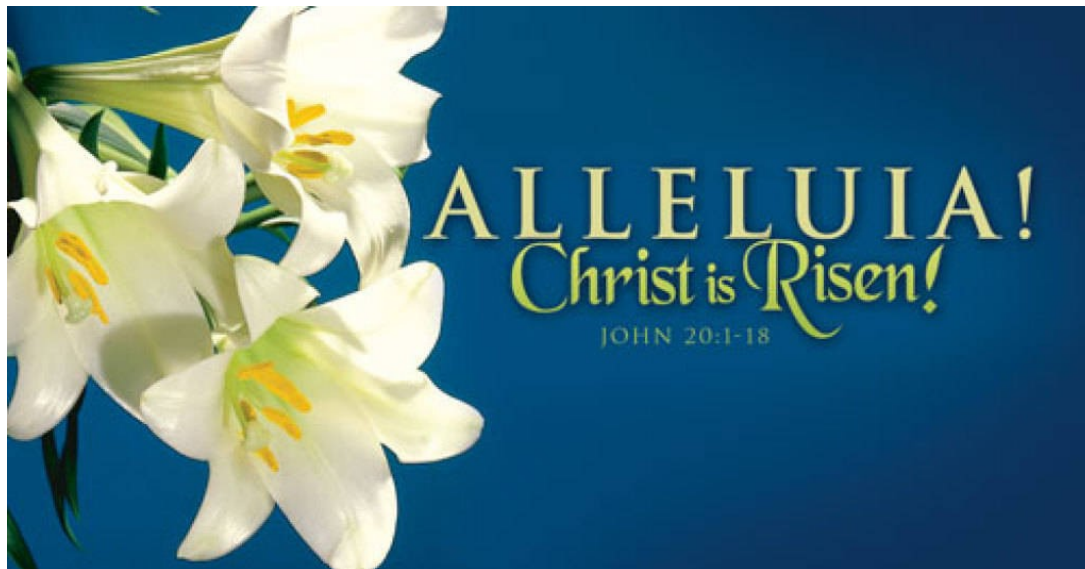

Time and Talent Hours Now Past Due

Dear Parents,

please keep in mind that each family is required to provide **16 hours** of school service each school year, **4 hours** of which must have been worked at the Bear Fair.

All time and talent hours performed after May 1 will be credited to the next school year.

School administration and the HFS Advisory Board recognize that there may be an unforeseen emergency which prevents the family from meeting this requirement.

If this happens, parents must pay a Time and Talent assessment fee of **\$300 (or \$25/hour) by May 1st** for the required **12 hours of service**.

If parents or guardians do not show up or make prior arrangements for their **4 hours of required Bear Fair** time an additional **\$400 (or \$100/hour)** assessment fee will be charged to that family.

All Time and Talent hours should have been logged into the on-line submission form **prior to April 15, 2019**.

If you have not submitted your hours, you will be assessed a Time and Talent fee.
