

Diocese of Baton Rouge Child Nutrition Program 2022-23 Meal Application Information

During the 2022-2023 school year, the Child Nutrition Programs across the America will be returning to pre-COVID standards. This means families are required to complete and submit meal applications to see if their child/children qualify for free or reduced priced meals.

Redemptorist St Gerard and St Francis Xavier will continue to operate under the CEP program (Community Eligibility Provision). The students who attend one of these two schools will receive free meals (breakfast and lunch) for the 2022-23 school year. These families are not required to complete the meal application.

The easiest way to complete and submit a meal application is via the CNP website at <https://cnpbr.org/parent-info>. Once on the Parent Info page, scroll midway the page and click on the **Free/Reduced Meal App** link under the 2022-2023 Free/Reduced Priced Meal Info section.
